## Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

(Mk. 6:30-34)

During his years of public ministry, especially in Galilee, Jesus was an immense hit with the masses. Almost everywhere he went common people flocked to him, some hoping for a cure, some just to feast their eyes on him and hear his voice. Most of their religious leaders and rich folk kept their distance, but ordinary Israelites took Jesus to their hearts.

No man could receive such acclaim and not be moved by it.

In this passage Mark not only captures Jesus at the peak of his popularity; he shows how this popularity affected him. Those who sought him he welcome, at whatever personal inconvenience.

The action opens in Capernaum, the lakeside town that served as home base for Jesus during his Galilean days. The apostles had just returned from their first missionary excursion. In his name and at his bidding they had journeyed through nearby villages, healing the sick and preaching the need for repentance.

To their delight, these maiden endeavors had met with success.

Bubbling with excitement, they wanted to tell Jesus the story of their exploits. Bu the house where he was staying was in confusion, overflowing with admirers and petitioners. The apostles found their hands full just trying to control the comings and goings of these well-meaning invaders. So great was the melee that there was scarcely time to eat.

Like the apostles that with excitement wanted to manifest to Jesus the joy of the success in their first mission preaching the gospel and healing the sick. In the same way for us Christians to preach the Word of God in our church, our communities and families.

**THE DAYS ARE COMING**

Separation, isolation, and hostility are terrible things. We are, sadly, too familiar with all of them in our modern life, whether we look at world events or events in our own neighborhoods and families. All three readings today refer to these same sad human conditions.

The prophet Jeremiah describes world conditions as if the people of his time were sheep who had been scattered by poor leadership and corrupt shepherds. But “the days are coming,” he assures us (Jeremiah 23:5), when a new shepherd, a just king, will come. We meet that king in the second reading and the Gospel. Paul reminds us in the Letter to the Ephesians that all divisions can now cease in Christ Jesus, who has brought us together through his blood. In Mark’s Gospel we see Jesus himself, looking with pity on those searching for him as if they were sheep without a shepherd.

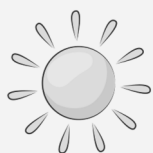

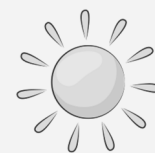

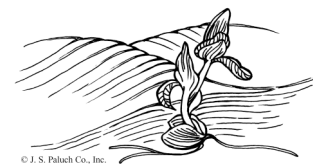

## Decimosexto Domingo de Tiempo Ordinario

**Marcos 6:30-34**

Durante sus años de ministerio público, especialmente en Galilea, Jesús tuvo un inmenso éxito entre las masas. Casi dondequiera que iba la gente común acudía a él, algunos con la esperanza de una curación, algunos sólo para fijar sus ojos en él y escuchar su voz. La mayoría de sus líderes religiosos y gente rica mantuvieron su distancia, pero los Israelitas comunes se llevaron a Jesús en sus corazones.

Ningún hombre podía recibir tal aclamación y no ser conmovido por ella.

En este pasaje Marcos no sólo captura a Jesús en la cima de su popularidad; sino que muestra cómo le afectó esta popularidad. A los que lo buscaron él les daba la bienvenida, a cualquier inconveniente personal.

La acción comienza en Cafarnaúm, la ciudad a orillas del lago que sirvió como base de operaciones para Jesús durante sus días galileos. En su nombre y a su petición habían viajado por pueblos cercanos, curando a los enfermos y predicando la necesidad del arrepentimiento.

Para su deleite, estos esfuerzos tuvieron éxito.

Burbejando de emoción, querían contarle a Jesús la historia de sus hazañas. Pero la casa donde se alojaba estaba en confusión, rebosante de admiradores y peticionarios.

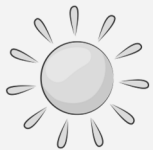

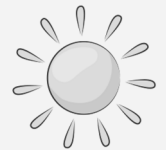
