Have you ever heard the story of the multiplication of the loaves and fishes, about that day with more than 5000 families who did not have enough food? Imagine you are one of those people who were sitting and happy because you had been listening to the Lord all day, but when it is time to eat you realize that there is a problem: there is no food and you are hungry. You and the disciples are worried and start asking what can be done? Suddenly, a boy shows up, with five loaves of bread and two fish. Jesus

winks at him, receives him with love, and gives him thanks. You are amazed because you see the Creator of everything multiply the loaves and fishes. You eat and see how everyone is filled.

It is wonderful how this miracle begins with a child. Any resemblance to reality is not pure coincidence. Everyone else sees problems, the people because they are hungry, the disciples and friends of Jesus because they have no money, but a child could give away everything he had. I imagine that this little boy with a big heart said to himself: Well, if we all put in what we have, at least we will have something.

We too have loaves and fishes. Maybe they are not loaves and fishes as such but think of them as these. If one of us has a skill, we can teach it to someone who does not have it; if one of us lives happily, we can share a pleasant moment with someone who feels sad. If one of us has a word of encouragement or a piece of good advice, we can share it with someone in need.

Jesus is now with you, He winks at you, and you give him what you have. The first loaf can be your hope that today will be a better day, the second loaf can be your job or studies, the third loaf can be praying a little bit, and so, every day, you give Jesus your five loaves and two fish.

Now, what can you share?

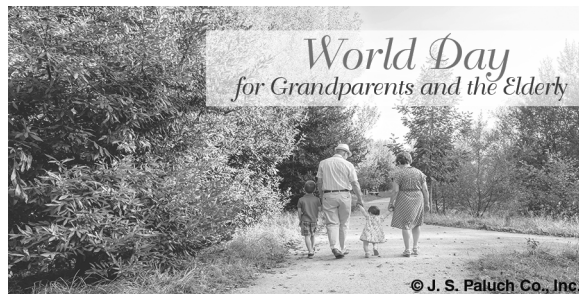

**ONE LORD, ONE FAITH**

Do you suppose the authors of the four Gospels were aware of today's first reading from the second book of Kings? Of course they were. The prophet Elisha fed a hundred men with twenty barley loaves in order to prove God's power. This same miracle, now multiplied by more people fed by fewer loaves, is attributed to Jesus in all four Gospels. In today's passage from John we even have the detail that the loaves were barley, reminding every pious Jew of that miracle that Elisha worked. Yet Jesus went into hiding when they wanted to make him king. It is the passage from Paul's Letter to the Ephesians that gives us the reason for this. The power of Jesus comes from God. It is not meant merely to feed us, or to provide one group with a king. There is one Lord, one faith, one God and Father of all who works through Jesus Christ and through us all.

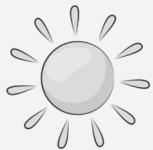

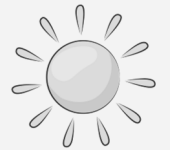

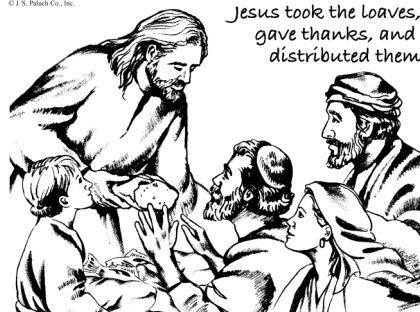

### Reflexión del Domingo

¿Alguna vez has escuchado la historia de la multiplicación de los panes y los peces, alrededor de ese día con más de 5000 familias que no tenían suficiente comida? Imagínese que usted es una de esas personas que estaban sentadas y felices porque había estado escuchando al Señor todo el día, pero cuando es hora de comer te das cuenta que hay un problema: No hay comida y tienes hambre.

Ustedes y los discípulos están preocupados y empiezan a preguntar qué se puede hacer? De repente, un niño aparece, con cinco panes y dos peces. Jesús le guiña, le recibe con amor, y le da las gracias. Se sorprenden porque ven al Creador multiplicar los panes y los peces. Usted come y ve cómo todos están llenos.

Es maravilloso cómo comienza este milagro con un niño. Cualquier parecido a la realidad no es pura coincidencia. Todos los demás ven problemas, la gente porque tienen hambre, los discípulos y amigos de Jesús porque no tienen dinero, pero un niño pudo dar todo lo que tenía. Me imagino que este pequeño con un gran corazón se dijo a sí mismo: Bueno, si todos ponemos lo que tenemos, al menos tendremos algo.

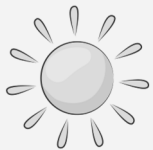

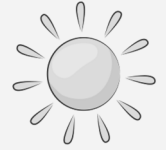
