### FEAST OF FAITH

#### Sanctus, Sanctus, Sanctus: Song of Heaven

The words of the Sanctus are rooted in the scriptures. They recall the song of the seraphim in the prophet Isaiah's vision of God in majesty: "Seraphim were stationed above; each of them had six wings: with two they veiled their faces, with two they veiled their feet, and with two they hovered aloft. 'Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts!' they cried one to the other. 'All the earth is filled with his glory!' " (Isaiah 6:2-3). They recall the Gospel accounts of Jesus' entry into Jerusalem: "Hosanna to the Son of David; blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord; hosanna in the highest" (Matthew 21:9). Yet the liturgy adds something new to these ancient texts. The seraphim sang, "the earth is filled with his glory." But the liturgy proclaims, "heaven and earth are full of your glory." In the Eucharist, earth and heaven meet. For a moment in time, we join in the song that the angels sing for all time. The Sanctus raises us to heaven, but does not remove us from the earth. It is the song of the King who took on our human flesh so that we might share in his divine life. —Corinna Laughlin, Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.

### **Decree on Indulgences for the Year of St. Joseph**

*"An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury of the satisfactions of Christ and the saints." - Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1471*



***Excerpts from the Decree on Indulgences in the Year of St. Joseph  
of the means to gain plenary indulgences  
Consecration to St. Joseph***

The Plenary Indulgence is granted under the customary conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayers according to the Holy Father's intentions) to the faithful who, with a soul detached from any sin, shall participate in the Year of Saint Joseph, in the occasions and with the modalities indicated by this Apostolic Penitentiary.

Contemplate the Lord's Prayer for at least 30 minutes, or participate in a Spiritual Retreat of at least one day which involves a meditation on St. Joseph

Fulfill a corporal or spiritual work of mercy, after the example of St. Joseph.

Recite the rosary as a family and among betrothed (engaged couples).

Entrust their daily life to the protection of St. Joseph. All faithful who shall invoke through prayer the intercession of the Worker of Nazareth, so that those in search of work may find employment and the work of all people may be more dignified.

Recite the Litanies to Saint Joseph (Latin) or the Akathistos to Saint Joseph, whole or in part (Byzantine) or some other prayer to Saint Joseph for the Church persecuted and for the relief of all Christians who suffer any form of persecution

In addition to the above, a plenary indulgence is granted to any faithful who shall recite an approved prayer or do an act of piety in honor of St. Joseph, especially on the occasions of: March 19th, May 1st, Feast of the Holy Family, Sunday of St. Joseph (Byzantine), the 19th of every month, and every Wednesday.

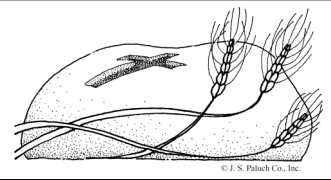
In the current context of the health emergency, a plenary indulgence extends particularly to the elderly, the sick, the suffering, and all those who for legitimate reasons are unable to leave the house, and who with a soul detached from any sin and the intention to fulfill the three customary conditions in their own place shall recite an act of piety in honor of St. Joseph, Comfort of the Sick and Patron of a Happy Death, offering to God their suffering and the hardships of their life.

#### **Prayer to St. Joseph**

"O Saint Joseph, do assist me by your powerful intercession, and obtain for me from your Divine Son all spiritual blessings, through Jesus Christ, our Lord, So that, having engaged here below your heavenly power, I may offer my thanksgiving and homage to the most Loving of Fathers."
