Celeste del Nuevo Mundo y la Madre de las Américas”. Patrona de México y una de las Advocaciones Mariana más populares en el mundo entero.

Esta Fiesta maravillosa de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe es sin duda una ocasión especial y muy apropiada para recordar y refrescar esa relación “afectiva, hermosa y maternal” que tenemos con nuestra Madre Santísima. 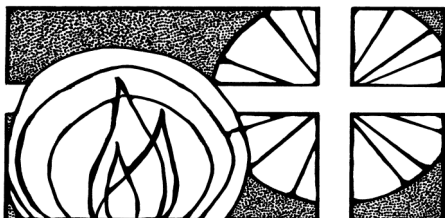

Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Lord:

This weekend we embark on and embrace a great liturgical, religious, family oriented and beloved celebration in our Catholic Church: The Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Crowned by Pope St. John XXIII as "The Celestial Missionary of the New World and the Mother of the Americas"; Patroness of Mexico and one of the most popular Marian vocations in the world.

This wonderful Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe is undoubtedly a special and very appropriate occasion to remember and renew that "affective, beautiful and maternal" relationship we have with our Blessed Mother. Blessed Mary of Guadalupe, our "Virgin Morenita", is par excellence our Virgin and Mother to whom we all seek protection and consecrate ourselves to.

In the words of Pope Francis: "*Mary is our Mother, she is the Mother of our people, she is the Mother of all of us, she is the Mother of the Church, but she is also a figure of the Church. And, she is the Mother of our heart, of our soul. Because the Church is feminine and our soul has that capacity to receive grace from God, in a sense, the Holy Fathers saw it as feminine. We cannot think of the Church without this extended Marian principle.*"

And of course, we live that maternal relationship in our daily lives, in our parish communities and throughout our Universal Church. Because the love we profess for our Mother of Guadalupe leads us to feel the presence of God's love in our lives and to bring that sweet love to all our brothers and sisters without any particular distinction other than her love of a Mother. In this regard, Pope Francis again illustrates and explains in his words: "*Mary is a woman, she is our Lady, Mary is the Mother of her Son and of the Holy Mother Hierarchical Church, Mary is a mestizo, a woman of our people, but she mestized God*". Holy Mary of Guadalupe, always Mother, always with her children.

Let us therefore join in the joy and revelry of the Church this 2021 on the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe and may that unheeded love that accompanies us with the deep devotion of our hearts for our Virgin of Guadalupe, inspire, enlighten and strengthen us in that advent walk with immense hope and joy.

My Dear Parishioners,

I want to start by thanking all those who gave so generously this year, of their time, talents, and money. Please keep in mind that through your generosity, St. Joseph of the Palisades Parish, and its many programs, can continue to do the work of the Lord.

As you can see by the attached Financial Statement, the annual cost to operate our parish is over \$1.8 million. Salaries and benefits total \$ 811,000; utilities and maintenance of our facilities costs \$650,000; the Archdiocesan assessment, which includes support of the school system in our Diocese, totaled \$189,000; financial aid to our very own school was \$ 100,000; and expenses for various ministries and Parish programs, that address both the spiritual and social needs of the community, exceeded \$ 50,000.

Just as our families became more financially strained with the rising cost of health insurance, utilities, taxes, general upkeep of our properties, and the cost to educate our children, the parish shares these very same issues. In fact, we realized that this year we have a deficit of over \$790,000 and \$ 767,000 the year before. This means that the Parish needed to draw-down on the funds we received from the sale of one of our buildings to fund these deficits.

St. Joseph of the Palisades Parish has an important Catholic presence in this area. The Parish addresses the spiritual, social and financial needs of one of the most diverse communities within the Archdiocese of Newark. During this past year alone, the Parish community celebrated 104 Baptisms, and 102 Confirmations; witnessed 26 weddings, and held 79 funerals and 51 memorial Masses. In addition, the Parish gave over \$25,000 of financial aid outside of Parish borders those that were hit by storms and famine. In order to continue to provide these services the Parish depends heavily on your support and generosity.

In the Book of Sirach in the Old Testament we are told: "In generous spirit pay homage to the Lord, be not sparing of freewill gifts. Give to the Most High as He has given to you, generously, according to your means. For the Lord is the one who always repays, and He will give back to you seven-fold." (Sirach 35:7-10).

A Thought: Have you ever noticed that generous, giving people seem to be happier and more in love with life than those who are selfish and stingy? Is it their happiness that makes them generous or is it their generous spirit that brings them happiness?

Again, I thank you for your support, your dedication and most of all your prayers. Together let us continue to make our Parish all that it could be.

May God Bless us all and show us the way to Bethlehem.

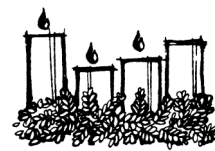
Mis estimados feligreses,

Quiero comenzar agradeciendo a todos los que donaron tan generosamente, este año, de su tiempo, talentos y dinero. Por favor, tenga en cuenta que, que a través de su generosidad, la Parroquia de San José de Palisades continuar haciendo la obra del Señor. Adjunto puede ver el estado financiero donde se explican los diferentes costos. La cantidad necesaria anual para operar nuestra parroquia es de más de \$ 1.8 millones. Los sueldos y beneficios ascienden a \$ 811.000; los servicios públicos y el mantenimiento de nuestras instalaciones cuestan \$ 650,000; el aval de la Arquidiócesis, que incluye el apoyo del sistema escolar en nuestra Diócesis, ascendió a \$ 189,000; la ayuda financiera para las matriculas de nuestra propia escuela fue de \$ 100,000; y varios ministerios y programas parroquiales que abordan las necesidades espirituales y sociales excedieron los \$ 50,000.

Así como nuestras familias se volvieron más tensas financieramente con el aumento del costo del seguro médico, los servicios públicos, los impuestos, el mantenimiento general de nuestra propiedad y el costo de educar a nuestros hijos, nuestra Iglesia comparte estos mismos problemas. De hecho, nos hemos dado cuenta de un déficit de más de \$ 790,000 este año y \$ 767,000 el año pasado. Esto significa que San José necesita utilizar los fondos que recibimos de la venta de uno de nuestros edificios para poder financiar estos déficits. San José de Palisades es una importante presencia católica de esta área y no solo cubre las necesidades espirituales sino que también las sociales y en ciertos casos, las financieras de una de las comunidades más diversas dentro de la Arquidiócesis de Newark. Durante este año, la comunidad parroquial celebró 104 bautismos y 102 confirmaciones; celebró 26 bodas y también hubieron 79 funerales y 51 Misas conmemorativas. La parroquia otorgó más de \$ 25,000 en ayuda financiera a personas necesitadas. Para continuar brindando estos servicios, la parroquia depende en gran medida de su apoyo y generosidad.

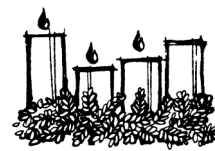
