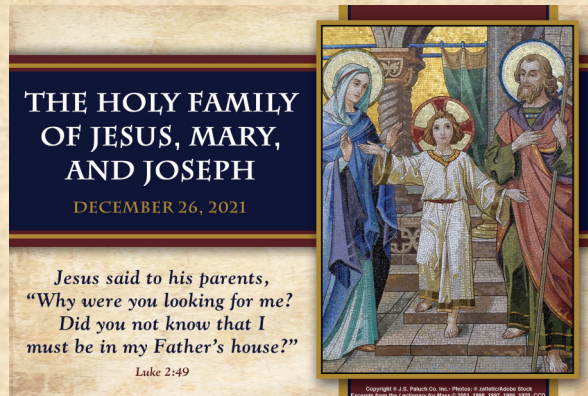

The Holy Family

Cicle C: Lc. 2,41-52

Today the church is celebrating the feast of the Holy Family, a model for Christian families because of the characters who comprise it.

If we consider each of its members we can determine their virtues, discover their trials in their daily lives and distinguish their perfections.

In Joseph we can see the figure of the perfect father and husband: Committed to his obligations even though he is not the biological father of the Child Jesus; Faithful to his wife, Mary, and protector of his family in the mission entrusted to him by God through the Angel; by his difficulties as a submissive man and respectful of Mary and Jesus; an honest worker committed to the defense of his family when he emigrated to Egypt to protect the Child Jesus from the persecution of the Emperor. Joseph is the image of an honest and willing man chosen to fulfill the mission entrusted by God the Father to care for Mary and the Child. He is the model of a holy man capable of sacrificing himself and renouncing his own desires for the good of the Holy Family.

We can distinguish in Mary the pure and chaste young woman who renounces her plans and desires as a woman in order to place herself at the complete disposal of the Father: "Behold the handmaid of the Lord, your Holy Will be done in me." We see Mary's total disposition as the fruit of her unconditional dedication based on her prayer, humility and candor in the acceptance of God's saving plan. She is the perfect woman worthy of becoming the Mother of the Son of God and the Co-Redeemer of the human race, starting from the announcement of the Angel to the cross in front of Calvary, and the caretaker of her Son's faith in our Church to this day. She is the model of a Mother for all women who have the joy of being mothers that care and educate their children in a healthy and holy manner.

Of Jesus we can say that as a man he was cared for by these parents, suffered exile, the inclemencies of the weather and the space that he shared with them, was subjected to other languages, customs and laws of Egypt and his nation of origin, and to the Judaic formation of his parents. But in the midst of all this he grew up to be a righteous man with harmonic physical and psychological development.

The Holy Family is a magnificent example and model for all families. May your families imitate the virtues, sacrifice and tenacity of the Holy Family. Perhaps there won't be so many families destroyed by hatred, ambition, violence and intolerance; where the life and integrity of the human being will be respected; where children can grow up in the midst of the love, warmth, security and loving protection of a father and a mother together until death separates them. May the Holy Family of Nazareth bless and protect your homes. Amen.

FAMILY LIFE

Christmas celebrates the Incarnation, the “en-flesh-ment” of God as a human person. In Jesus, God is bodily present in the human story. Today we honor the Holy Family, helping us to see that God is active in daily family life. God is near at hand, amidst the tensions, joys, and uncertainties of family life. As our Gospel passage describes, even with family miscommunications and with limited understanding of Jesus’ mission, the Holy Family persevered in their life together. Like many family conflicts, there was no immediate or clear resolution of the issues raised by Jesus and by Mary. God’s intentions for the family, and for Jesus, were still unfolding. They continued to stay connected with each other and with God. Within the turbulence of family life, they trusted God to actively sustain and guide them into an uncertain future. We are invited to follow their example.
