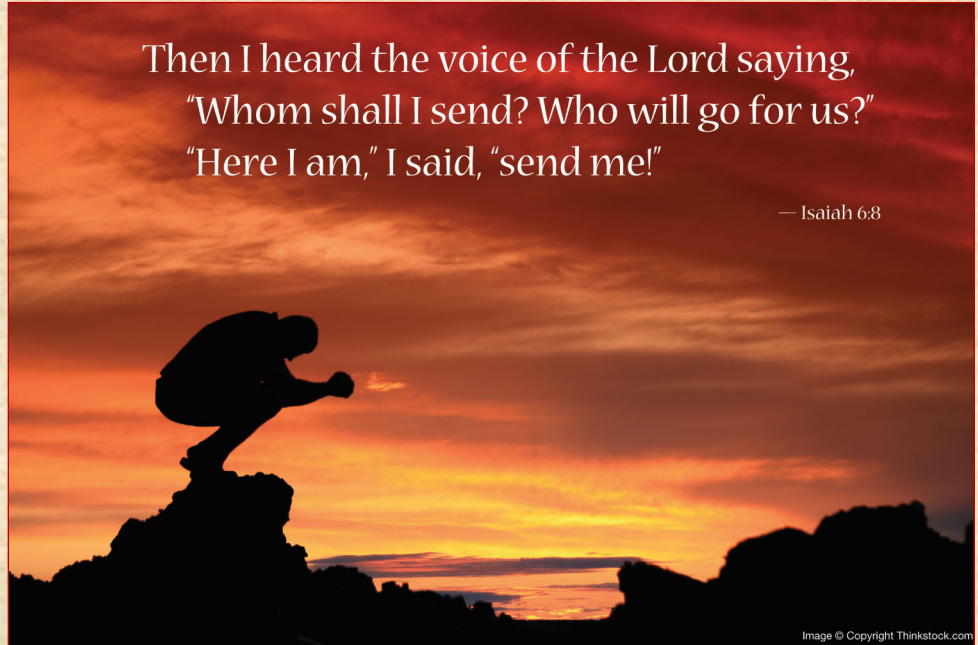

The Duty of Hospitality

The *POPULORUM PROGRESSIO*, a document of Pope Paul VI that was published in 1967, reminds us that we will always insist on the duty of hospitality - the duty of human solidarity and Christian charity - which is incumbent on both families and cultural organizations in all countries to welcome foreigners. It is necessary to increase the residences and homes that welcome, above all, young people. Firstly, this is to protect them against loneliness, the feeling of abandonment and anguish which destroy all morale. Also, to defend them against the unhealthy situation in which they find themselves, forced to compare the extreme poverty of their homeland with the luxury and waste that often surrounds them. And also to shelter them from subversive doctrines and aggressive temptations that assail them at the memory of so much "undeserved misery" #46. Above all, finally, to offer them the warmth of a fraternal welcome, the example of a healthy life, the esteem of authentic and effective Christian charity, and the appreciation of spiritual values. With great joy I can say that these values are practiced and spread in a concrete and effective way in our "community in action" of Saint Joseph of the Palisades in West New York. I appreciate the dedication of our programs and ministries that contribute greatly to this cause, especially Grupo Paz y Bien and our Food Pantry, which support immigrants who come to our local and parish community with their love and hospitality. This is one of the qualities of our Parish that I discovered from the first moment I arrived at Saint Joseph's: The capacity for welcoming and the hospitality that it offers to acquaintances and strangers. I invite the entire community of this beautiful parish to constantly join the call of Christ to be in solidarity with our most needy brothers and sisters and to continue building the civilization of love as a path to the salvation of all humanity. *Populorum Progressio #48*

Black History Month Celebrated with Special Masses

Parish Communities Also Invited to Join Synod Listening Sessions

The Archdiocese of Newark's African American, African, and Caribbean Apostolate will celebrate Black History Month with four special Masses and Synod listening sessions during the month of February.

Though the Archdiocese traditionally commemorates Black History Month with one large Mass celebrated by Cardinal Joseph W. Tobin, C.Ss.R., Archbishop of Newark, in Newark's Cathedral Basilica of the Sacred Heart, this year the Apostolate decided to celebrate with four smaller Masses in local parishes to make the celebration more accessible and personal for parishioners. One Mass will be held in each of the four counties overseen by the Archdiocese — Bergen, Essex, Hudson, and Union — with the county's bishop presiding. All are invited to attend to honor Black culture and its impact on American history.

THEOPHANIES

Today's readings recount three theophanies, or particular manifestations of God's presence. The prophet Isaiah is caught up in a dramatic scene of heavenly worship, with a royal throne, burning embers, and seraphim singing, "Holy, holy, holy." Isaiah is overwhelmed. In the responsorial psalm, the assembly adds its own worship to that of the seraphim: "In the sight of the angels, I will sing your praises, Lord" (Psalm 138:1).

Paul reminds the Corinthians of his own experience of a post-Resurrection appearance of the Lord, making him an apostle, but one "born abnormally" (1 Corinthians 15:8), since he had no acquaintance with the earthly Jesus. The first of those who did know the earthly Jesus were surprised by fishing advice from the teacher who had commandeered Simon's boat, resulting in an extraordinary catch. Although less colorful than those of Isaiah or Paul, this theophany was just as overwhelming.

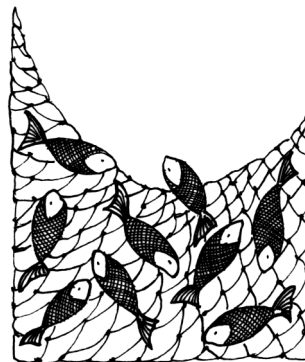

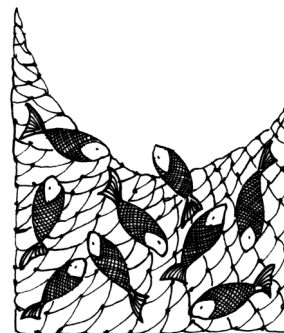

El deber de la hospitalidad

La *POPULORUM PROGRESSIO*, documento del Papa Pablo VI y publicado en 1967 nos recuerda que no insistiremos nunca demasiado en el deber de hospitalidad —deber de solidaridad humana y de caridad cristiana— que incumbe tanto a las familias como a las organizaciones culturales de los países que acogen a los extranjeros. Sobre todo, en fin, para ofrecerles, con el calor de una acogida fraterna, el ejemplo de una vida sana, la estima de la caridad cristiana auténtica y eficaz, el aprecio de los valores espirituales. Con gran alegría puedo decir que estos valores son practicados y difundidos de manera concreta y eficaz en nuestra "comunidad en acción" de San José de Palisades en West New York. Agradezco la dedicación de nuestros programas y Ministerios que aportan grandemente a esta causa especialmente el Grupo Paz y Bien y nuestro Banco de Alimentos (Food Pantry), los cuales apoyan con su amor y hospitalidad a los inmigrantes que llegan a nuestra comunidad local y parroquial. Esta es una de las cualidades de nuestra Parroquia que descubrí desde el primer momento en que llegué a San José: La capacidad de acogida y hospitalidad que brinda a conocidos y forasteros.
