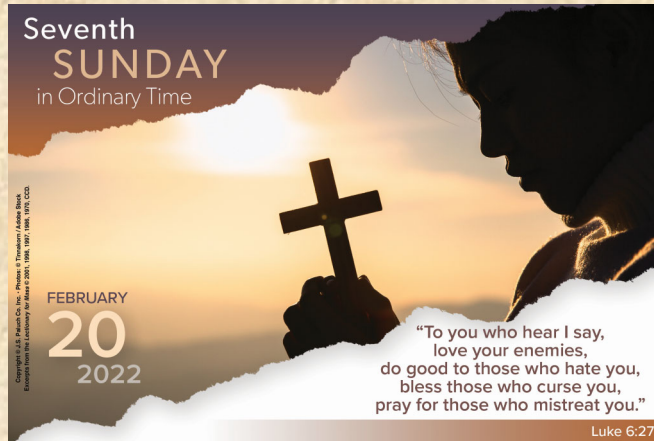

Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Lord:

We celebrate the Seventh Sunday of Ordinary Time this weekend and we encounter a “bunch” of invitations from the Lord deeply molded in the proclamation of the “Gospel”, to proclaim and touch the hearts of our brothers from our personal commitment.

The preacher Deacon Ken Finn tells us: “Jesus makes us know very precisely in this reading that love is a decision and not a sentimental emotion of little consistency. He tells us that anyone can love someone who is easy to love or who in his time will return love to us. And he goes further by saying that even the pagans love their families and friends. And he says anyone can love under those circumstances. Jesus asks us for something more than a sentimental YES, He asks us for a decision, a decision of love.”

As we can see, it is a clear invitation from the Lord to live and embody the gospel in our lives, something that goes beyond a mere romanticism and meaningless sacrifice of “turning the other cheek”; It is a profound and sincere answer to the way of “Loving God,” that is, we are called to live in a different “logic” than that of the world. To show that the response we give to the Lord’s call and our concrete responsibility implicates a commitment to our brother, to the community and to the ecclesial and human society that we conform to.

In the midst of this reflection and invitation, it would be good for us to reflect on the following questions:

- What talents and virtues do I feel I should cultivate these days?
- How am I living my personal judgment with others? How have I judged others?
- What do I feel I need to do to repair any damage from my criticism?

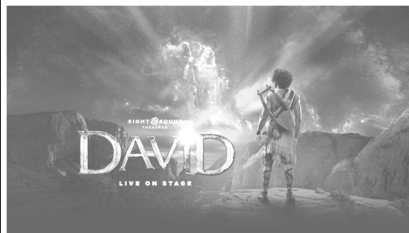

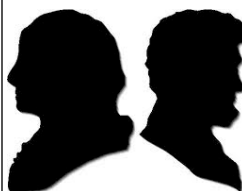

LOVE AS GOD LOVES

Our Gospel today continues Jesus' Sermon on the Plain, in which we heard Luke's version of the Beatitudes. This week, Jesus gives us new "commandments," telling us how to live and act in the world as his disciples, rooted in the radical love of God for humanity. It reminds us of his later speech about loving one another as he loves us, in other words with a God-like love, the kind we see in today's psalm about God's mercy. How else could we do as Jesus tells us by loving our enemies, which seems impossible, until we remember that God gave us the example of Jesus, who is like God but also like us? David understands this merciful love when he spares the life of his enemy in the first reading. Finally, Paul tells us that we will become like Jesus if we act as he did, as God does.
